



Fibra Nova announces a new lease agreement in Juárez City

Chihuahua, México, January 22th 2020 – Banco Actinver, S.A. Multiple Banking Institution, Grupo Financiero Actinver Fiduciary of F/2870 trust or Fibra Nova (BMV: FNOVA) a Mexican infrastructure and real estate trust, announces that it has executed a new five-year lease agreement starting on March 1, 2020 for a building of 165,000 square feet in Juárez city. The Lessee is a US public company listed in the NYSE with annual sales of US\$8,700 million.

Fibra Nova during the past twelve months achieved annualized 12% revenue growth. US dollars revenue climbed from 21% to 39%.

About Fibra Nova

Fibra Nova is a real estate investment trust (FIBRA) that began operations on August 3, 2017, identified with No. F/2870. Fibra Nova's strategy is based mainly on the acquisition, lease, operation and development of properties destined to sectors with economic dynamism and that capture the benefit of the demographic bonus such as the industrial, retail and educational sector.

In order to maintain FIBRA status, articles 187 and 188 of the Income Tax Law establish that FIBRAS such as Fibra Nova are not subject to the payment of income tax in Mexico and must distribute at least 95% of their net tax result annually to the holders of their CBFIs and invest at least 70% of their assets in real estate for lease, among other requirements. Fibra Nova is managed internally by Administradora Fibra Norte, S.C., supported by a solid corporate governance and a competitive structure aligned with the interests of investors, making Fibra Nova an unprecedented investment vehicle for the FIBRAS market in Mexico.
